Re: Tom Pickert Murder

Dear Unit Commander:

Due to false information being distributed to the media on 10/25/17 by Kari Thompson of the Kansas City police media unit provided to her by the homicide unit, my reputation is being destroyed through out the United States. I have had calls from friends and business associates from the West coast to the East coast believing that my white Chevrolet Van was present at the murder scene of Tom Pickert's murder due to false information put out by your department. Both my bank and insurance companies are concerned about dealing with a murder suspect and people who I have know for years and considered friends just look away when we meet. I would like for this false information to be corrected by your issuing a press release with the following facts:

1. There is not and was never one shred of evidence that David Jungerman's 1997 Chevrolet van license number 6FA453 was seen at the scene of Tom Pickerts murder. The police department was given information that Mr. Pickert had won a six million dollar civil judgement against David Jungerman and this made Mr. Jungerman a suspect at that time. The homicide department then called the Missouri Department of Motor Vehicles and learned that Jungerman owned a 1997 Chevrolet Van and issued a pickup order for that vehicle knowing that the only evidence the homicide department had was that a white van, and there must be 20,000 in the Kansas City area, was seen at the murder scene and there was no evidence whatsoever indicating the white van scene at the murder site belonged to David Jungerman.

2. There has not been one shred of evidence collected by the homicide department's investigation to date connecting David Jungerman with the murder of Tom Pickert.
3. Mr. Jungerman is not a suspect nor a person of interest at this time in the murder of Tom Pickert.
4. The K.C. Police department made a full investigation of the shooting of Mr. Jeffery Harris which was the subject of the lawsuit Jeffery Harris vs. David Jungerman which was won by Mr. Pickert for Mr. Harris to the tune of six million dollars. The facts from that police investigation were given to the prosecutor by the KCPD and the prosecutor determined that Mr. Jungerman shot Mr. Harris and his partner, Bob Wallace, in self defense and filed no charges against Mr. Jungerman.
5. Due to the tremendous damage being done to Mr. Jungerman's reputation by the false information distributed by the KCPD homicide unit placing his 1997 van at the scene of the murder and him being a suspect on 10-25-2017, we ask the media to help the KCPD to correct this assault on Mr. Jungerman's reputation.

Attached are numerous examples of the false information being distributed by the media due to your first putting out and then failing to correct your false statements to the press.
